

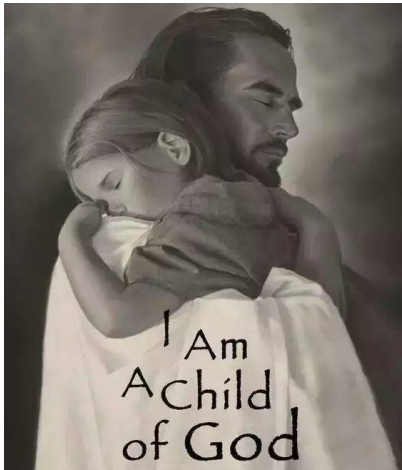

Miraculous Meetings...

I was not going to mention this story at first, it didn't seem interesting enough, but then I started seeing God's powerful hand in this, and it led to many miraculous meetings, and God touching the hearts of Chinese people here on campus.

Stray cats? Well that is how it began. As I walked on campus, I noticed many stray cats climbing into garbage cans to get food. Some of them looked very sick, and were probably starving. So I bought some cat food, and started feeding them in a couple points on my daily walks. I taught the cats to come when I whistled, so now it's quite a funny site to see; as I call the cats, they come running!



As I walk, sometimes I see one or two of the cats before the next feeding place, so I tell them to "come" and then I become the pied-piper, as a few cats are trailing behind me.

It's quite funny to witness!

It is common here in China, to have grandparents taking care of the children who are too young to go to school. So every morning I greet them with "Hello. Good Morning" (in Chinese) as I walk, and a second greeting to those who stop to see me and the cats. They smile really big when they hear my greeting, and it brings joy to me as well, to see them smile.



Seeing a foreigner taking care of animals, that no one else is taking care of, has been touching the hearts of my neighbors. I get many "thumbs up" as they stop or pass by, heading to the grocery store. One translated comment was, "It is easy to feed the cats one time, it is a very difficult thing, to feed them every day." Another translated comment was, "You have a very kind heart." I told him, "I am a Christian, and that God has changed me, and helped me have a kind heart." This was translated to him.



One day a woman (Tian) stops with 2 children on a moped-type scooter. The children were so excited, they came running to the cats! The cats scampered away (lol), then slowly returned. One



of the cats likes to play, so I gave the toy I bought to the young girl, and she laughed



and smiled as she played with the cat for 15 to 20 minutes.

I took these

pictures (above) and texted them to a friend of mine. My friend recognized the family, and sends the pictures to the mother (Tian) – who was standing next to me. God was smiling...

This turned out to be a Christian family who I wanted to meet, but did not have any opportunity. I was told Tian and her husband lived in the same campus rental area, but I didn't know where they lived, or what they looked like. God planned the meeting time, and the meeting place, around feeding stray cats! Then, within a week after meeting them, they invited me to their son's 2nd birthday party, and I was blessed to spend time with this family, and another Christian couple. Just the 7 of us shared lunch and some birthday cake.



The miracle continues: On Thanksgiving weekend, my brothers and sisters had planned a party, and all of us invited many friends and neighbors. The day before our party, a woman (Zi) and her son stopped as the cats were eating, and later the son played with one of the cats for quite a while. Seeing God's hand in this, I wanted to invite Zi and her husband, to our Thanksgiving party. The problem is that I don't speak enough Chinese to communicate with her, so how can I invite them?



How does God resolve this problem? Guess who shows up...

My new friend Tian, on the Moped! She stopped for only a minute – just to say “Hi” to me. And as it turns out, Tian and Zi live in the same building, just two floor apart, and they already know each other! So Tian invited Zi and her husband to join our party (the next day), and we were excited to see them come. Thank You Jesus!

This was the first time Zi's family joined our Sunday party, and heard about God and His love for them. They had plans in the afternoon, so could not join the afternoon Thanksgiving party, but God was giving them an opportunity to hear of His love for them. And to strengthen the relationship between Tian and Zi. It was a beautiful thing to see. God's love in action.

A simple, kind act is touching many hearts here – and establishing relationships. Among this Chinese neighborhood, a “foreigner” stands out, and my actions get noticed. Compassion is seen. Friendliness opens doors. Relationships are building. God is here, and these people need God. We all need God.



Everyday people stop to see the stray cats, and the children get excited. The cats are starting to look healthy, and their fur has become beautiful. It takes only 40 to 60 minutes a day. Soon I will learn enough Chinese to talk with my neighbors, and deepen the relationship that is being built now.



God touches hearts, and He brings them to us to help them, and to love them. How wonderful the past 2 months have been. Such an answer to our many requests to our Father.
