Earnestly seek God... Thirst for God Dwell in His Presence...

"You God, are my God, earnestly I seek you; I thirst for you, my whole being longs for you, in a dry and parched land where there is no water." Psalm 63:1

Psalm 63 was written by King David, when he was in the desert of Judah. David spent many years in different desert

places, when he was being pursued by King Saul, fleeing for his life.

Here are some of the deserts David lived in, that are mentioned in the book of 1 Samuel:



Desert of Ziph (23:14), Desert of Maon (23:24), and the Desert of En Gedi (24:1).

King David was <u>intimately</u> familiar with desert life, and the need and pursuit of water. Here David talks of how he seeks God, thirsts for God, and longs for God – and equates it with the need and pursuit of water – where there is "no water".

This really speaks to my heart. How critical it is for us

to seek God – every day. To long for God, as one who longs for water – living in a place where there is no water.

I think this is an important challenge for us – to earnestly seek God in this way. Draw close to God, and He will draw close to you.

"As the deer pants for streams of water, so my soul pants for you, my God. My soul thirsts for God, for the living God. When can I go and meet with God?" Psalm 42:1-2

I also had another interview and job offer (to teach English to children) the day before. Both of these opportunities, God has brought to me. It was amazing to see, and this really touched the heart of my roommate – to see how God brought both of these about.



So on Monday 1/29/18, I taught my first class to 7 children, and another cool thing? They met me at the door, with the temperature being 23°F outside, and said in English, "WELCOME



TEACHER". It was such a wonderful greeting, and a great way to start teaching children, here in China!

Regular school classes in China are large, so personal attention is not common here. These classes I teach will be about 5 to 7 students, and I can spend some quality time with each one of them. Teaching and encouraging, as I love to do. ©
