July marks six months living in Prague, and we are grateful for what God has done to establish our home and ministry through friends and ministry partners. We have made significant progress in settling into our routine and beginning outreach. In our neighborhood and church community, we are reaching out to Mirka, Daniel, Peter, Vojtěch, Šárka, Berenika, and others. All are Czechs who speak English, but we continue to study Czech.

We are meeting with campus organizations and have been scouting for outreach opportunities on the Polytechnic University campus, which is a ten-minute walk from our home, and we are looking into possibilities for an official status there. Please continue to pray that the Holy Spirit speaks to the hearts of these dear people and that we can make strategic connections on the campus.

I turn sixty-two in September, but my heart still burns for the next generation. As I have weekly prayer walks on campus, I also do some of my studying there to have more opportunities to meet new people.

This is the start of phase two of the church plant. We filed our church incorporation documents with the court a few days ago, which will allow us to bring in new team members sustainably for the campus. Our sponsor here, Pastor Jakub Limr, has graciously offered to translate our One-2-One discipleship book, and we should have that by the time the fall

campus schedule begins. We just started the application process for temporary residency, which is a significant upgrade from our long-term visas. Please pray for favor with Czech immigration and a smooth process.
